Use number lines
Learn about Roman numerals
Find 1,000 more or less
Compare and order numbers to 10,000
Round numbers to the nearest 10, 100 and 1,000
Addition and subtraction of 4-digit numbers, with exchanges
The children will also be focusing on their times tables, beginning with the 3s, 4s and 8s. They will explore other times tables up to 12.
